

Finding Appointed Referees using RugbyFirst

Once you're onto the internet, the best way to find your club on RugbyFirst is to enter this address into your address bar: <http://clubs.rfu.com/Clubs/>



This should take you to a page that looks like the one below. Enter your login detail into the boxes, click 'Login', and this should take you to your Club. (If you need these, please contact Paul Renton at paulrenton@rfu.com)



If this doesn't work, click the 'Clubs near me' box, type in your club's name, select 'Club' from the options and click 'Go'

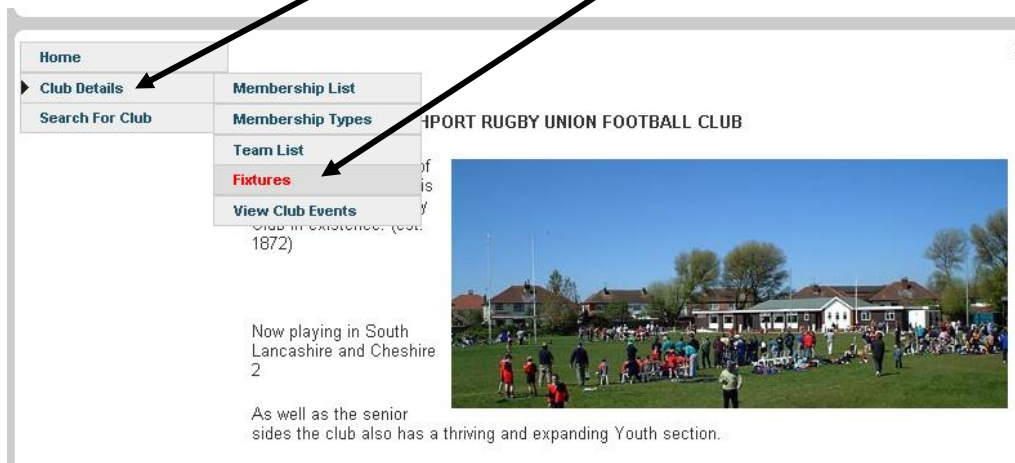

If your Referees' Society is using RugbyFirst to make their referee appointments, when you go to your fixtures by using the 'Club Details' and the 'Fixtures' option, as shown in the example for Southport below
