As part of the recruitment process the RFU requires all adults who are involved in Under 18 rugby to be in possession of a valid CRB disclosure obtained through the RFU.

To assist the RFU in its risk assessment process anyone who may have a criminal record is offered the opportunity to detail the offences and explain the circumstances surrounding them. This information should be sent directly to the RFU, where it will be stored securely and only viewed by members of the Child Protection Referral Management Group.
