

**NORTH HYKEHAM RUGBY CLUB GIRLS TEAMS “PLAYERS PROTOCOLS”**  
**COMPILED BY THE TEAM AT A SQUAD MEETING 4TH AUGUST 2006**

The following protocols have been compiled for the girl’s teams by the players themselves. They are the subject of periodic review. Now that these protocols are in place they should be adhered to by all players within the club. A copy of these protocols will be posted on the club notice board and included in the Club Policy Folder. Each player will also receive a copy of this document and will be required to sign up to the Codes of Conduct. Pig Fines may result if any of the below codes are repeatedly breached.

1. All players should have a positive outlook and seek to improve their rugby skills. Players should ENCOURAGE each other.
2. More experienced players should be prepared to help new members. New players MUST be made to feel welcome from the very first night.
3. Players MUST work as a team - this means regular attendance at training on Thursday evening as well as playing in matches for the club.
4. ALL players should be treated with respect and MUST be prepared to listen to each others views.
5. Players should listen to and follow the instructions of the coaching staff at all times.
6. DO NOT give up, either in training or matches.
7. NO BACK CHAT OR SWEARING. DO NOT LOSE YOUR TEMPER IF THINGS ARE GOING AGAINST THE TEAM ON THE PITCH, OR GOING WRONG IN TRAINING.
8. Players should concentrate only on the rugby at training sessions and matches. Issues outside of the sport SHOULD NOT be brought to either training or matches.
9. Rugby is about fun and enjoyment. HAVE FUN BE HAPPY!!
